SUBJECT: "Historical Earthquakes and Recent Seismicity of the Continental Borderlands of Southern California." Mr. Legg has been compiling and studying both historical records of earthquake activity and recent epicenter data. Using this information, he has identified several linear trends indicating previously-unmapped off-shore faults. The implications of this faulting in terms of seismic risk to San Diego are obvious, and should be of interest to all SDAG members working in the local area.
