Alan is a principal investigator and project manager for Dames and Moore. He received his B.A. in Geology at UC Santa Barbara in 1977 and has since participated in projects throughout the western United States and abroad.

TOPIC:

GEOLOGIC AND GEOTECHNICAL PROBLEMS ASSOCIATED WITH AN 1800 MEGAWA'TT NUCLEAR POWER PLANT IN KOREA.

Alan will provide a brief review of some of the problems encountered and resolved during foundation investigations and design of an 1800 megawatt nuclear power plant in Korea. Foundation materials consisting of variably weathered metamorphics and intrusives presented interesting foundation design considerations. In situ deformability testing, geophysics and finite element applications were utilized to resolve many of the problems encountered. Additionally, the Korean approach to rock mechanics problems provided an interesting insight into some of the differences in the application of engineering geology.
