Mr. John Peterson, San Diego County Hydrogeologist "Update: San Diego County Groundwater Regulations and Research"
Many changes have been made to the San Diego County Groundwater
Policy. This Policy, which was revised last year, will be discussed
and explained. In addition, a number of conclusions from the Lee Valley Groundwater Investigation and groundwater monitoring program will be described. The County is also investigating the possibility of additional control on the development of new wells on existing lots. Many lots, which were approved for imported water, are having wells constructed. This could adversely impact the local groundwater system.
