
SKI TRIP TO MAMMOTH

EMERSON FAULT TRACE IN UPPER JOHNSON VALLEY

LANDERS EARTHQUAKE of JUNE 28, 1992

Field Trip date: February 26, 27, and 28, 1993

Get yourself to the intersection of Interstate Freeway 10 and Highway 62. Go north from there on Highway 62 to the town of Yucca Valley where you will turn north on Highway 247. Follow Highway 247 for approximately 29 miles to Bessemer Mine Road. Watch closely on the left (SW) side of the road for an approximately 5'x6'green sign with white lettering - at that point you will turn right (NE) onto Bessemer Mine Road. Follow this dirt road for approximately 14½ miles to the camp site - see map on reverse side. The camp site is located in a wash just east of the Emerson fault trace that broke during the Landers Earthquake.

This will be a dry camp, so bring everything you will need.
