

#### FIELD TRIPS!

**2002 Field Trip – SEPTEMBER 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup>!** Pat Brooks is planning the 2002 SDAG Field Trip which will feature the geology and mineral resources of northern Baja California. The 2002 SDAG Field Trip will be a joint venture with Universidad Autonoma de Baja California (UABC) in Ensenada. Jorge Ledesma Vasquez, Geology Chairman, will sponsor coastal geology stops, including the Agua Blanca Fault at Punta Banda. Stops in Sierra Juarez (south of Tecate) will include the abandoned scheelite mine, El Fenomeno, that features granite pegmatite, skarn, and hydrothermal minerals, and Dr. Dave Kimbrough will sponsor a stop on La Posta-type intrusions. Details are being worked out for the Estero Beach Hotel to host our group on Saturday evening. They can cater to a large group and provide a room for a presentation. Rates are very reasonable. It is a nice place, but overnighting at the hotel will be more expensive than unrolling your sleeping bag. The hotel allows campers (not tent camping). If this idea seems too expensive, please let me know. Once the final cost is estimated, an e-mail registration form will be sent out. Carpooling is a must and participation will be limited to about 75.

## SCGS 30<sup>th</sup> Annual Fieldtrip: Come for the Wine Stay for the Faults: Geology, Tectonic Geomorphology, and Groundwater Resources of the Santa Barbara Wine Country.

October 12-13<sup>th</sup>. Join the South Coast Geological Society for a great weekend in the Santa Barbara wine country! On Saturday, we will come away with a much better appreciation of the role of geology in the development of the Santa Barbara wine region of the Santa Ynez Valley. We will come away with a much better understanding of the wines too. Our leaders in this field will be Dr. Merilark Padgett-Johnson, professor of Viticulture and Enology at Alan Hancock College, Dr. Daniel Roberts of Kendall-Jackson Winery Estates and Mr. Bob Johnson a vineyard director of ~ 1600 acres of wine grapes in Santa Barbara. We will also have some stops like a landslide-dammed lake, the Little Pine faults zone, and even some highly abused rocks.

On Sunday, we will visit the La Conchita Ranch and discuss the fascinating landslide (and legal and groundwater) history impacting this elevated failing, marine terrace and sea cliff. We will also explore the active faults and folds along the Santa Clara River, including recent paleoseismic studies of the San Cayetano fault that appear to point to it as the source of the 1812 Santa Barbara earthquake. Our leaders for Sunday include Tom Rockwell, Bob Yeats, Larry Gurrola, Eldon Gath and other surprise visits to be announced in the near future. We will be camping at the Sage Hill Group Campground along the Santa Ynez River enjoying all benefits of a typical SCGS field trip gathering.
