An approximately 6 ft. high Hoodoo developed on ancient colluvial material overlying a steep slope on the west side of Pacific Ranch Road 150 ft south of Brand Crest near Encinitas. Underlying bedrock is Torrey Sandstone. The resistant cap is a cemented soil horizon developed on the colluvium.
